RULES OF CONDUCT

7. You may not physically harm, threaten to harm, or harass any person, including provoking and/or engaging in physical fights or malicious pranks.
8. You are responsible for complying with the requests of all Texas State Historical Association personnel, hotel personnel, and security personnel.

STUDENTS WHO VIOLATE THESE RULES WILL BE SUBJECT TO PUNISHMENT, UP TO AND INCLUDING FINANCIAL RESTITUTION AND EXPULSION FROM THE ANNUAL MEETING AND THE HOTEL. SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS AND PARENTS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY MISCONDUCT OR RULE VIOLATION.
